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Immunizations Coverage Report

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The *Immunization Coverage Report, State of Utah: 2020,* supports the mission and goal of state and local immunization programs which is: ".... to improve the health of Utah citizens through vaccination to reduce illness, disability, and death from vaccine-preventable infections."

This annual *Immunization Coverage Report* provides an overview of immunization information about Utah residents, organized by immunization coverage status for Utah children, adolescents, and adults. The report presents data obtained from four primary sources: the National Immunization Survey (NIS), the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), the Utah Statewide Immunization Information System (USIIS), and the APPX web application used for tracking immunization coverage rates from Utah schools, licensed day care facilities, and long-term care facilities. Descriptions of these sources and the methodologies used in data reporting are described throughout the report. Because of the differences in the collection methodologies of these data sources, care should be taken before considering comparisons.

This report can be a resource for local immunization programs in evaluating coverage areas, identifying gaps in services, developing immunization intervention strategies, and in considering further investigations.

An ongoing focus of immunization coverage is the infant and early childhood population. According to the 2019 National Immunization Survey (NIS), Utah ranked 7th in the nation for the number of two-year-olds who were fully immunized. The NIS reports an estimate of the number of children who have completed the recommended childhood immunization series 4:3:1:4:3:1:4 (4 DTaP, 3 Polio, 1 MMR, 4 Hib, 3 Hepatitis B, 1 Varicella, and 4 Pneumococcal vaccines) by 24 months of age.


Despite improvements in coverage rates in recent years, there is still work to be done to achieve the *Healthy People 2020* objective to reduce, eliminate, or maintain elimination of cases of vaccine-preventable diseases. The focus of the Utah Department of Health Immunization Program continues to be those areas where immunization efforts can be concentrated to affect significant improvements.

Continuing efforts to increase childhood immunization levels include a variety of interventions, including ensuring healthcare providers have current information on immunization best practices, implementing a coordination project with the Intermountain Pediatric Society, and enrolling diverse providers in USIIS. The Utah Immunization Program (UIP) maintains collaborations with school nursing staff, the Utah State Board of Education, child care licensing facilities and local health districts. These combined efforts will help to ensure Utah children are protected from vaccine-preventable diseases now and into the future.

Statewide and national information is presented for comparison.

Early Childhood Immunization

The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), establish standards of comparison for immunization status. Up-to-date (UTD) at age two is the percentage of children 24 months of age who have received all doses of recommended vaccines. This standard is used across the U.S. by state immunization programs and provider sites to evaluate their effectiveness in protecting children from vaccine-preventable diseases.

Child and Adult Immunization

Exposure to groups of people of any age increases the risks for contracting and transmitting infectious diseases. More than two-thirds of children younger than six years and nearly all children older than six years spend significant time in child care and school settings outside the home. The Utah Immunization Rule for Students (R396-100) became effective in 1975 to implement consistent requirements to protect children attending school.

School Entry (Kindergarten & 7th Grade)

Required kindergarten school entry immunizations include: DTaP, Polio, MMR, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis A, and Varicella vaccines.

Required 7th grade school entry immunizations include: Tdap, MMR, Hepatitis B, Varicella, Meningococcal, Polio, Hepatitis A and DTaP vaccines.

Influenza and Pneumococcal

The incidence of childhood vaccine-preventable diseases has declined dramatically, but similar successes among adults have not been achieved. Adults still suffer the vast majority of certain vaccine-preventable diseases in the U.S.

The 2019 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) survey results on influenza and pneumococcal immunization data are included. These data, by means of a number of different analyses, provide a summary of coverage of influenza and pneumococcal vaccinations for adults 18 years of age and older.

Appendix B includes 2019 immunization information for residents of long-term care and assisted living facilities. This data is collected by the Utah Department of Health Immunization Program through the APPX Web Application.

National Immunization Survey (NIS)

The NIS is sponsored by the National Center for Immunizations and Respiratory Diseases (NCIRD) and conducted jointly by NCIRD and the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) at the CDC. The NIS is a random-digit-dialing telephone survey of parents followed by a mailed survey to children's immunization providers, for which the contact information supplied by the parents. The survey requests immunization information from the providers. The results are tabulated and presented by the CDC. The average sample size per cohort is 400 individuals. For example, in 2018, information for 19 - 35-month-old children was collected for 453 children in Utah; healthcare provided immunization records were used to verify the reported immunization history of 257 of these respondents.

Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS)

The Utah BRFSS is an ongoing information collection effort by the Utah Department of Health in conjunction with the CDC to assess the prevalence of and trends in health-related behaviors in the non-institutionalized Utah adult population aged 18 years and older. The BRFSS survey is conducted by Utah Department of Health (UDOH) employees who contact Utahns by landline and cell phones and use a script and questionnaire to conduct interviews and collect responses. The CDC then aggregates annual results. In 2019 for Utah, 2,635 interviews were conducted by landline phones and 9,494 interviews were conducted by cell phones. The Utah response rate (complete and partially completed interviews divided by completed, partially completed, and refused/break-off interviews) was 54.8%.

APPX Web Application

The APPX Immunization component is a web application used for the purpose of tracking immunization coverage rates for Utah schools, Head Start programs, licensed daycare facilities, and long-term care facilities. The Utah Department of Health Immunization Program staff access the application to track data and run reports required by state rules. Users at schools, Head Start programs, daycare facilities, and long-term care facilities access the web application to enter immunization data for their facilities.

Utah Statewide Immunization Information System (USIIS)

Established in 1998, USIIS collects, consolidates, and manages immunization records for Utah residents of all ages. The primary sources of USIIS data are healthcare providers, including public clinics, private clinics and practices, hospitals, and pharmacies (see table on the next page). Additionally, USIIS contains birth certificate data from the UDOH Office of Vital Records and Statistics. Participation in USIIS is voluntary; not all providers of immunizations participate. However, participation from all Vaccines for Children (VFC) providers is required. See page 125 for more details about the VFC program.

For the 2020 Immunization Coverage Report, USIIS person data were grouped into 13 local health district service areas by their most up-to-date ZIP code and county information. Coverage results reflect 2019-2020 data submitted to USIIS as of July 1, 2020. Child coverage results include approximately 90% of Utah children—persons 19 years of age and younger with at least one immunization. Adult coverage results include approximately 70-90% of Utah adults—persons age 19 and older with at least one immunization. Although USIIS data provides helpful vaccination estimates, it is not a comprehensive archive of all vaccinations in the state and should be interpreted with caution.

The target population for the NIS-Child is children who are or will be 19-35 months within a few weeks of being selected to participate in the survey and living in the U.S. The NIS is a random-digit-dialed survey of parents or guardians and includes data for more than 15,000 children annually. The telephone survey is followed by a questionnaire mailed to vaccination providers to obtain the children's vaccination history. Data are used to monitor vaccination coverage among 2-year-old children at the national, state, selected local levels, and some in U.S. territories.

NIS-Child measures were previously reported as an estimate of vaccine coverage for children age 19-35 months in each survey year. Beginning with data reported in survey year 2019, NIS-Child data is now reported for children age 24 months per birth year (e.g., 24-month-old children born in 2017 had data collected in the 2019 survey year). Due to this change, NIS-Child data reported here is not directly comparable to similar data in previous Immunization Coverage Reports produced by the UDOH.

Since 2007, the CDC has published annual NIS data for teen populations. This survey is similar to the childhood NIS. Survey responses are collected via telephone through random-digit dialing. Those who participated were asked to provide healthcare provider information so their verbal responses over the phone could be validated through the official immunization record. Children age 13–17 years were included in the study. Participants were asked about receiving meningococcal conjugate (MenACWY), MMR, Hepatitis B, Varicella, Tdap, and HPV vaccines. The CDC identified three limitations to this survey: 1) there could be bias due to non-response and households without landline telephones; 2) underestimation of vaccine coverage may have occurred due to the exclusive use of provider-verified records; and, 3) some state level and race/ethnicity level data should be interpreted with caution because of small sample sizes. Results from this survey have been reported on national and state levels, which can be seen in the tables below.



Online schools represented in this data include schools in Davis, Salt Lake, Southwest, Tooele, Utah, and Weber-Morgan health districts. Online schools may enroll students from any location in Utah and therefore were analyzed separately from the other schools in their district.

It is worth pointing out that online schools have total exemption rates approximately 2-6 times higher than public and private schools and approximately 2-3 times higher than charter schools.

The Immunization Quality Improvement Program (IQIP)

The Immunization Quality Improvement Program (IQIP) is an immunization quality improvement program designed for Vaccines for Children (VFC) providers. The purpose of IQIP is to promote and support provider level quality improvement efforts designed to increase on time vaccination of children and adolescents

IQIP Strategies

- 1. Schedule the next visit before the patient leaves the provider office.
- 2. Leverage the state immunization information system (USIIS) functionality to improve immunization practice.
- 3. Give a strong vaccine recommendation, specifically for HPV vaccine if the provider serves adolescents.

Each provider decides on a Strategic Implementation Plan with the IQIP representative. The representative will follow up at 2 months, 6 months, and then re-run the assessment rates and review the progress at 12 months.

IQIP visits for this year began in fall of 2019. Unfortunately, as implementation of the program has started, we were faced with the challenges of COVID-19 and did not finish the required 25% of IQIP visits to VFC providers. Fifty-four initial visits were completed which fell 34 below the required 88 visits. The CDC now allows us to start new visits via Google Meet. Providers who were not visited last year will be a priority in 2020-2021.


Immunization report for long-term care facilities

Long-term care facilities are required to report the influenza and pneumococcal immunization status of patients and the influenza and Hepatitis B immunization status of employees to the Utah Department of Health Immunization Program. Completion of the annual report is necessary to prevent sanctioning of a facility's license.

The report includes persons who are residents or employees of a facility between October 1 and December 31 of the survey year. The survey is completed online no later than January 31 of the following year. Facilities reporting include hospitals (swing beds and transitional care beds), nursing care facilities, small healthcare facilities, and type I and type II assisted living facilities. There were 365 licensed facilities in 2019; all but one facility reported for 2019.

The portion of the survey reported here is as follows:

- Influenza (flu) immunizations: given during the reporting time period for residents and employees;
- Pneumococcal immunizations: given at any time for residents only; and
- Hepatitis B immunizations: given at any time to an employee having direct patient contact.



































Vaccines for Children Program Report, 2019

The Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program helps provide vaccines to children whose parents or guardians may not be able to afford them. This helps ensure all children have a better chance of getting their recommended vaccinations on schedule. A child is eligible for the VFC Program if they are younger than 19 years of age **and fall in one of the following categories:**

- Medicaid-eligible
- Uninsured
- Underinsured
- American Indian or Alaska native

The CDC estimates vaccination of children born between 1994 and 2013 will:

- Prevent 322 million illnesses
- Help avoid 732,000 deaths
- Save nearly \$1.4 trillion in total societal costs

In the 2020 fiscal year, it was estimated that 319,601 children younger than 19 years old were eligible for VFC funded vaccines in Utah.

VFC vaccines can be administered by any enrolled VFC Program Provider. There are 44,000 providers enrolled in the VFC Program nationwide.
