

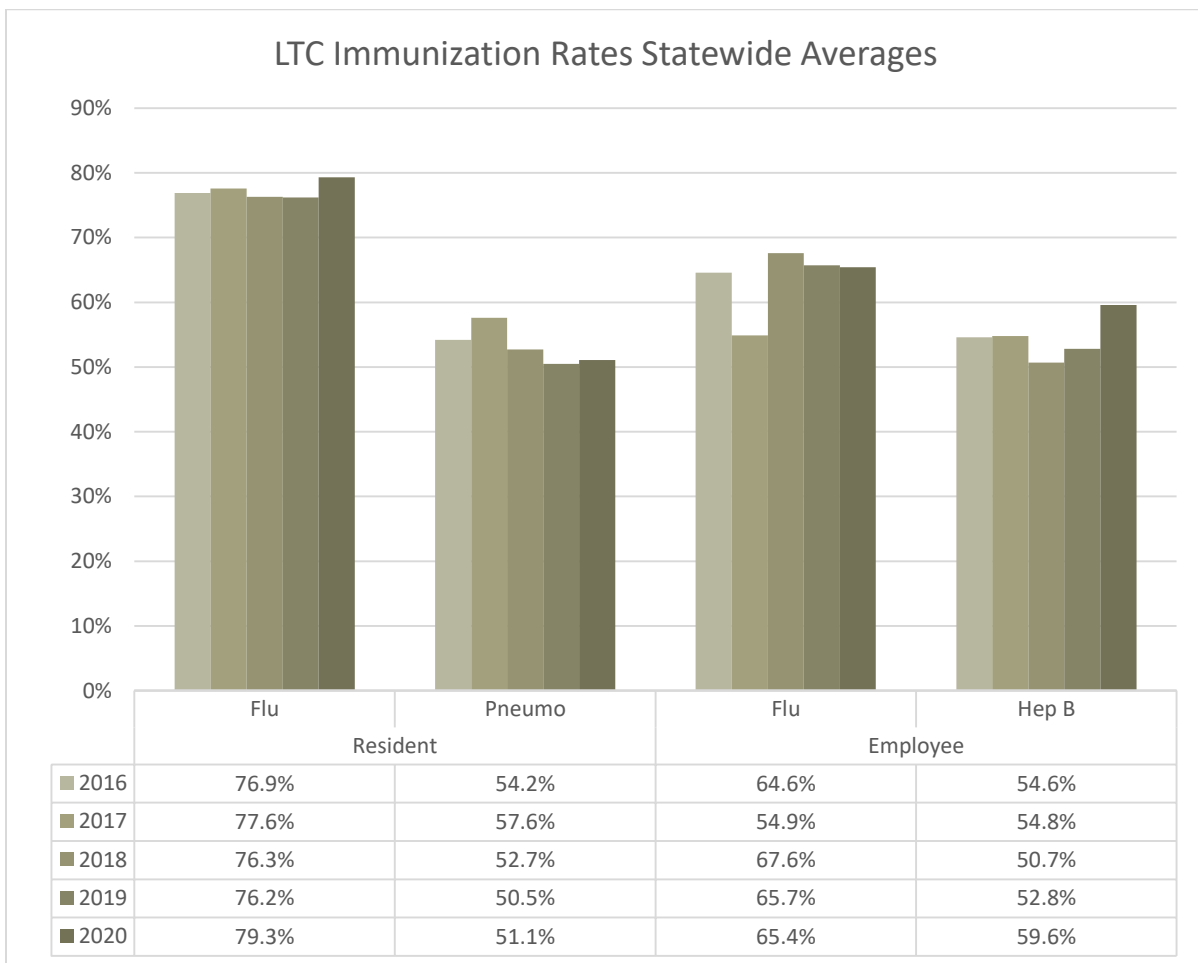
Immunization report for long-term care facilities

Long-term care facilities are required to report the influenza and pneumococcal immunization status of patients and the influenza and Hepatitis B immunization status of employees to the Utah Department of Health Immunization Program. Completion of the annual report is necessary to prevent sanctions of a facility’s license.

The report includes persons who are residents or employees of a facility between October 1 and December 31 of the survey year. The survey is completed online no later than January 31 of the following year. Facilities reporting include hospitals (swing beds and transitional care beds), nursing care facilities, small healthcare facilities, and type I and type II assisted living facilities. There were 355 licensed facilities in 2020; six facilities did not report for the year 2020.

The portion of the survey reported here is as follows:

- Influenza (flu) immunizations: given during the reporting time period for residents and employees;
- Pneumococcal immunizations: given at any time for residents only; and
- Hepatitis B immunizations: given at any time to an employee having direct patient contact.
