

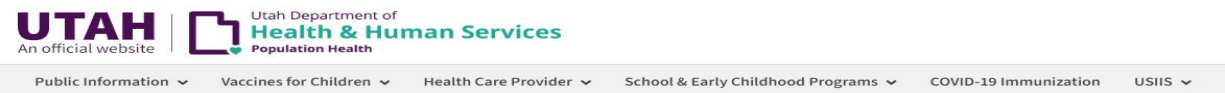
Students enrolling in kindergarten through twelfth grade or early child programs, whose legal guardian is claiming an exemption to immunization for medical, religious, or personal reasons, must complete an online immunization education module at immunize.utah.gov or attend an in-person consultation at a local health department.

A copy of the exemption form must be presented to the school or childcare official, along with a statement signed by a licensed healthcare provider for medical exemption.

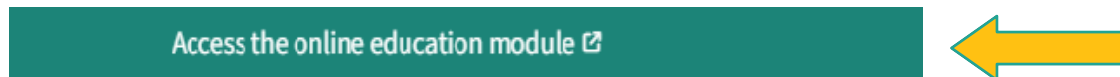

HOW TO COMPLETE THE IMMUNIZATION EDUCATION MODULE

1. Access the education module by visiting immunize.utah.gov.
2. Hover over “School & Early Childhood Programs.”



3. Scroll down and select “Online education module (Exemptions).”
4. Scroll down and click the green icon labeled “Access the online education module.”



5.  Sign in if you already have an account or create an account with a new user ID and password. For additional assistance, please visit idhelp.utah.gov for detailed instructions under “Account Creation.”

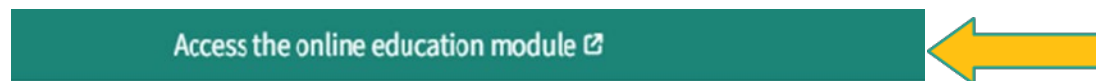

6. Once you have created your UtahID account, return to <https://immunize.utah.gov/immunization-education-module/>, click on "Access the online education module," and begin the module.



7. Enter user information. The user is the legally responsible adult completing this module.

Instructions

1. Enter the remaining required information below for the individual who is the legally responsible adult completing the immunization education module.
2. To view the Terms of service, click the box labeled Read Terms of service.
3. Once you have reviewed the Terms of service, to proceed with the module, click on the box, "I have read and accept the terms of service".
4. Information and agreements are not recorded until you click save. Once you have saved, you will be directed to the page to begin the module.

Terms

Terms of Service

I am using the Public Immunization Portal (PIP) to access my own personal information or information of another of which I am the legal parent or guardian, using my legal identity. I am not using PIP representing another person or using another person's information or identity, even if I have that person's written permission.

I understand that PIP and immunization records contain confidential information protected under [Utah Code](#).

I consent to the monitoring and recording of my use of PIP, including any electronic communications (such as click-to-chat or messaging).

I understand that it is a crime to:

- Give false or misleading statements to obtain information in government records;
- Give false or misleading information to obtain or alter confidential records; or
- Deceive the State of Utah about an individual's identity.

I understand that unauthorized use of PIP is a misrepresentation of my identity to the state government and could subject me to criminal or civil penalties, or both.

I understand that the state of Utah may stop me from using PIP if it finds or suspects misuse.

I accept the responsibility to properly protect any information provided to me by the Utah Department of Health and Human Services. I am the responsible party should any information on or from my computer or other device be improperly disclosed.

12. On the “Immunization Exemption Introduction” screen, follow the steps below to enter exemption information for your child.

- From the “Exemption Reason” drop-down menu, select the type of exemption: (Medical, Religious, or Personal). Only one exemption type can be selected.
- From the “Exemptions” drop-down menu, select the vaccines you are choosing to exempt your child from. You can select individual vaccines or choose to exempt your child from all required vaccines.
- Click “save” when you are finished, or “cancel” to exit without saving.
