The record will be in view mode only until a Patient ID has been added. You will have access to view the vaccine history, forecast and reports.
Edit Mode	Press to edit, add or change demographic information. *Please note you will need to enter a Patient ID.
Patient ID	The patient ID assigned by each facility that affiliates a record with their Provider ID. The Patient ID should be unique for each record. Schools use the student ID. Providers often use the auto generated ID given by the EMR/EHR system.
USIIS ID	USIIS ID is automatically assigned when a USIIS record is created. The USIIS ID is not editable. Each individual with a USIIS immunization record should have only one USIIS ID.

Buttons

Edit Mode	Press to enter and change demographic information for the person.
End Affiliation	Press if person is no longer a patient of the Provider facility.
Save	Displays after Edit Mode is selected and edits are made. Press to save edits.
Cancel	Does not save information entered or changed. Exits Edit Mode
Reset	Displays data from the last Save.

Demographics screen sub menu	
Demographics	Displays the Demographics screen – see above.
Comments	Displays the Comments screen – see below.
USIIS Immunize menu	
Search	Displays the Search screen.
Demographics	Displays the Demographics screen.
Immunizations	Displays the Immunizations History screen. Vaccine data entry.
Forecast	Displays the Forecast screen.
Contraindications	Displays the Contraindications screen, immunity and non-immunity options.
Reports	Displays the Reports screen – for patient specific reports. Includes: Utah School Immunization Record, Immunization History Report, Personal Utah Immunization Record, Recommended Patient Forecast.
Help	Instructions, tips and tricks, troubleshooting help.

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The Comments screen allows entry, viewing and deleting comments specific to the person, which can be marked as visible to all Provider facilities or only to the user's Provider facility.
